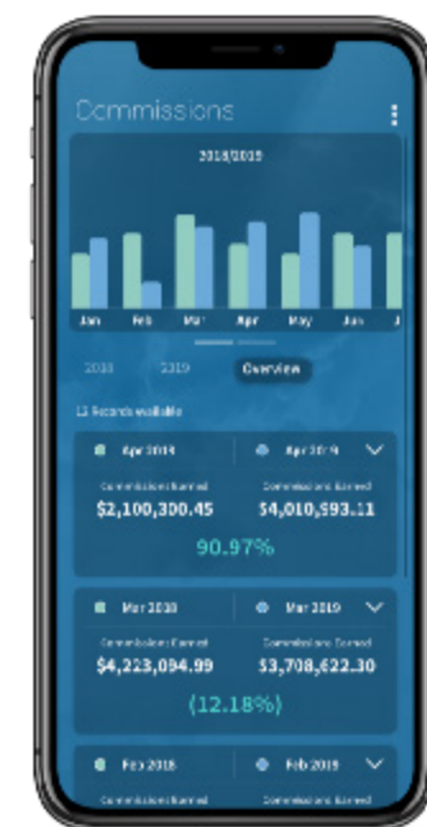

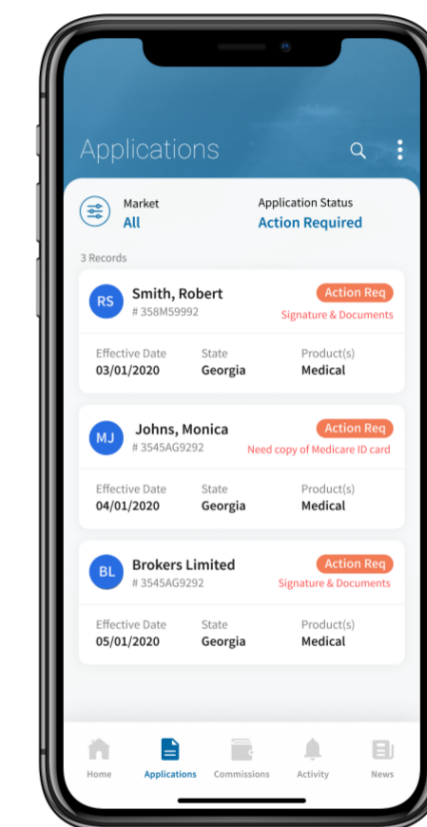

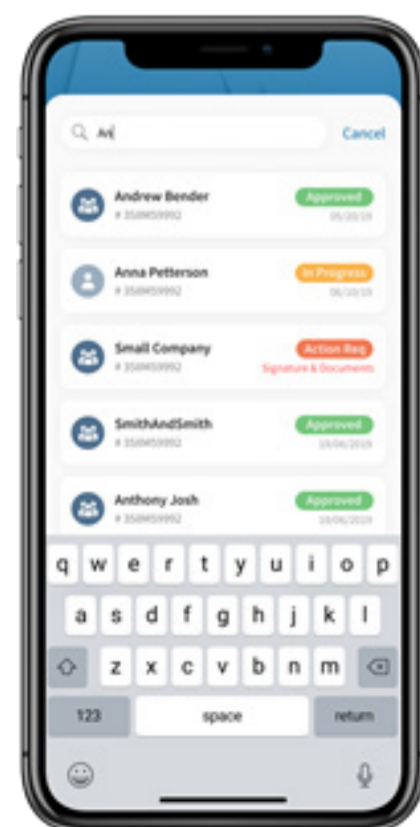

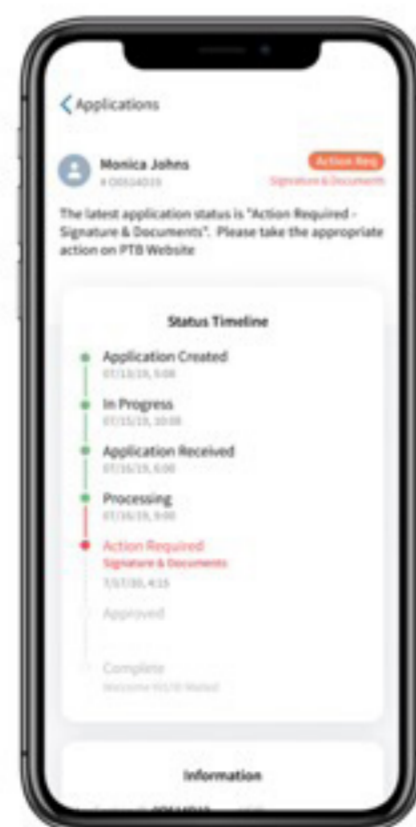


### Search

Navigate to applicant timeline and info

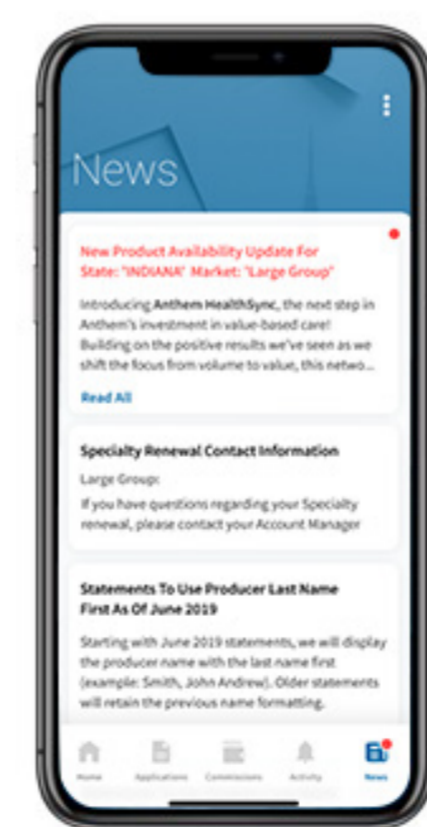


### Status

Tracker view of an application traversing through the different historical milestone

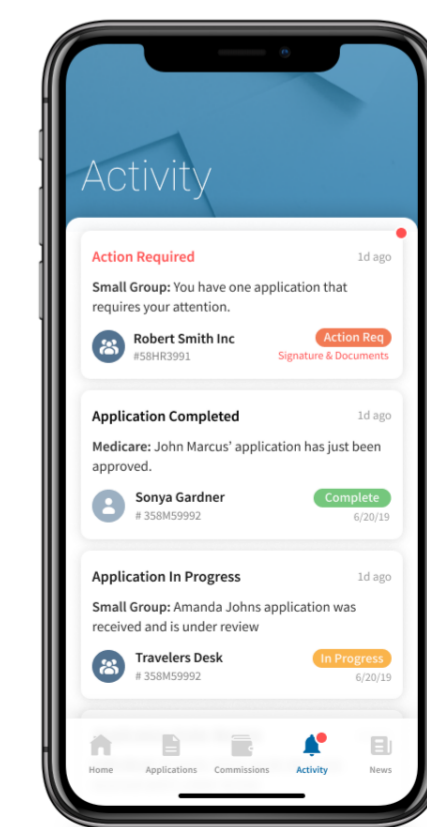
