Medicare Enrollment Checklist

You have **three options** when you are ready to sign up for Medicare.

You can apply **by phone, online, or in person** at a U.S. Social Security Administration office or online. It is best to make an appointment first if you want to go in person.

What you need to sign up in person:

- Original or certified copy of your birth certificate (or other proof of birth)
- Proof of U.S. citizenship or legal residency if not born in the U.S.
- Social Security card (if you are already receiving benefits)
- Copy of your W-2 form(s) and/or self-employment tax return for last year
- U.S. military discharge papers if you served before 1968
- Health insurance information (type and dates of coverage)

What you need to sign up online:

Date and place of birth. (Permanent Resident Card number if born outside the U.S.)

Health insurance information (Start and end dates for group coverage and employment)

If you are applying for a spouse in person at the Social Security Office, or signing up for Medicare by phone at 800.772.1213, **you may need to submit additional information.**
